REAL-WORLD EXPERIENCE ON THE USE OF BIOLOGICS IN CROHN'S DISEASE IN THE MIDDLE EAST

We are delighted to announce the preliminary approval of funding of our first regional multicenter collaborative research project: Real-world experience on the use of biologics for the treatment of moderate-to-severe Crohn's Disease in the Middle East: a retrospective cohort study (CHROME). This study aims to enroll 500 patients from the region in order to study outcomes on biologics in
